



Fall 2020 Programs

As typical Fall Outdoor School Programs were unable to run due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, we offered 3 new programs to families:

- Free Youth Active Living Days for grades 4-8
- Free Family Active Living Days for all ages
- A.C.T. Leadership Programs for grades 9-12 students

We also held a special free Halloween Evening for families on October 31st. Our Fall Program Staff did an exceptional job creating and implementing these new programs while ensuring constantly changing COVID-19 Health Protocols were followed. We were able to offer these programs in-person until November 22nd, after which we made the difficult decision to cancel all in-person programs and rental bookings for the rest of 2020, in the best interest of health and safety. The ACT leadership programs finished the rest of their season with online meetings. A free online Kampfire is also being hosted, on December 5th. Summer Kamp Winter Reunion has been postponed until we are able to hold the event safely.

In 2020 we engaged families through both in-person apple-themed family active living days on September 19 and 26 and through online events. With health and safety protocols in place we were able to run festival highlights such as juice pressing, apple archery and crafts. We also offered some new programming for the festival such as canoeing and an Indigenous Cultural Presentation by Walter MacDonald White Bear, a long-time facilitator with the SEEDS Connections Program.

We had around 100 people attend the 2 days, with the majority being new visitors to Kamp Kiwanis. We also raised over \$1,700 through our Online Silent Auction in support of Kamp.

We look forward to bringing back the traditional Kiwanis Apple Festival in 2021 and greatly appreciate the continued support of the community for Kiwanis Apple Festival.
